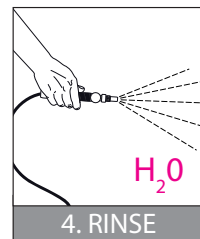
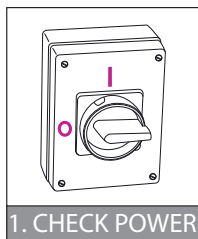

## Directions of use



Evaporators: fan may be kept running, depending on system configuration.

Condensers: turn system off. Isolate electrics.

If working in a confined area, ensure sufficient ventilation. Start cleaning at top, holding aerosol close to coil face. Work methodically, moving across the coil and then down. Ensure the coil is completely saturated. If necessary, place card or cloths behind the coil to catch loosened dirt. Repeated applications may be required for very dirty coils. Rinse thoroughly with fresh water.
